Dear Friends,

By means of this letter I want to introduce you to a few changes made in what you knew formerly as The Guadalupe Partners, now The Guadalupe Workers. Essentially, to describe it as simply as possible, we are smaller and more focused. We are more focused in that we are spending more time with the mothers whom we have already met at the abortion facility and with whom we have been working. Spending more time with these mothers is more possible now that we have our own office space in Detroit, in the old rectory of Saint Leo parish. We are there Saturdays and Wednesday evenings. The mothers come with specific problems, to pick up clothes and baby items, or sometimes just to chat. On Wednesdays they bring their older children, who receive academic tutoring from me or from Alicia.

Alicia has also scheduled a speaker series at the rectory. Our first one, at which Tina Sabga of Spiritus Sanctus Academy spoke, was well attended and appreciated by our mothers. They were allowed to bring their children (more than thirty!) who were tended by a group of teenage and adult supervisors.

Our next talk will be given by Denise Walker of Pro Life Action Ministries in Minneapolis.

This is how, then, we have become more focused in our work.

We have become smaller by centering our new corporate structure on a tight, three person board of directors: Alicia Wong, Edmund Miller and Patrick Cummings. Going small means we will have better communication, better knowledge, better overall understanding of what we are doing and where we are going.

Since we are registering as a totally new corporation, we are registered as a non-profit corporation but we have not obtained a 501c3 status yet. Until that time, however, we still need and are grateful for your support.
